Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

European Day, May 9th was celebrated in Tartu University by different events in three main locations.

Supported by project CAMINO Tartu University Museum (as partner in the current project) participated in organising an international conference “Our Choice and its Consequences: 20 years in the European Union” which took place in Tartu University Museum where also the international student photo exhibition “Inspired by Europe” (result of CAMINO project photo competition) was opened.

The conference participants were prominent Estonian researchers, scientists, analysts, politicians, teachers (incl prof of European Studies Piret Ehin, prof emeritus and former MEP Marju Lauristin, ambassador of Ukraine to Estonia Maksym Kononenko and ambassador of Georgia to Estonia Zurab Khamashuridze). There were more than 50 participants from university departments but also representatives of local government (head of Tartu Cultural Capital project). During **the opening of the conference a solemn moment** was dedicated to a moment in history 20 years ago when Estonia together with other Eastern and Central European countries united EU.

During the conference a book “Minu Eesti, minu Euroopa 20 aastat hiljem” [“My Estonia, my Europe 20 years later] collecting memories of different people participating in social and political processes during last 20 years through European perspective was presented and given to all participants. After that the CAMINO project **student photo exhibition “Inspired by Europe” was opened** (a week later the exhibition was transferred to the university main building to attract even more attention than in the museum).

Another event was taking place in one of the most modern University of Tartu Study and Research Buildings called “Delta”. During 1.5 hour period the European Day was celebrated through spreading information (information desk about European Union, European Studies in University) and CAMINO **project Flashmob video was presented**. Considering all the students walking by, the number of students who got involved was far more than the registered number; the signatures were collected from 97 students.

In the evening one more international creative exhibition called “Aken Toomemäe pool” [“A Window towards Toomemägi”] was opened. It is a poetry exhibition showing poems and pictures of poets representing different nationalities (Estonian, Finnish, Latvian, Ukrainian, Russian). Presented in public

space (park), the exhibition draws attention of citizens and visitors of city to international cultural heritage in Tartu.

Altogether 145 participants from 9 EU and 10 non-EU countries participated in the event, thus, the two core criteria for this WP – the number of countries and the number of participants – were fully met.
