Description

Provide a short description of the event and its activities.

The goal of the initiative was to host a public event in Poland to commemorate the 20th anniversary of the 2004 EU enlargement. This celebration took place on May 9, 2024, in front of the main building of the University of Opole (Collegium Maius) the events included:

- 1. A Tele-bridge that digitally connected partner universities, culminating in a joint flash mob performance of "Ode to Joy."
- 2. The inauguration of the International Student Photo Competition Exhibition.
- 3. A solemn ceremony commemorating Polish accession to the EU.

During the celebration on 9 May at 12:30, a Tele bridge was organized to digitally connect all partner universities in a joint flash mob performance of "Ode to Joy." This event took place outdoors, with a synchronized streaming of a flash mob video across all partner countries.

A big screen and audio equipment were set up for the simultaneous public screening of the video. The video featured an introduction and welcoming speech by B. Koller (UPS), followed by a joint flash mob performance of "Ode to Joy." This performance was a compilation of seven individually created flash mobs from Latvia, Poland, Lithuania, Slovakia, Hungary, Czech Republic, and Estonia, performed by various student ensembles and youth organizations to the music of Ludwig van Beethoven's "Ode to Joy" (the Anthem of Europe).

A dance to "Ode to Joy" and singing of the EU anthem by students of the State Music School in Opole took place. The event was attended by UO Rector Prof. Marek Masnyk, Opole Mayor Arkadiusz Wisniewski and Peter Herr - head of the Consulate of the Federal Republic of Germany in Opole.

Altogether 162 participants from 15 countries (10 EU and 5 non-EU countries) participated in the event, thus the two core criteria for this WP – the number of participants and the number of countries – were fully met.
